Awards: All awards will be determined by the advisory judges. Their decisions are final and no objections from participants will be accepted.

(A) Sections: P.5 Chinese, P.5 English, P.6 Chinese, P.6 English

(B) Individual Awards:

- 1. Champion: One per Section. Awards are a certificate and book coupons with a total value of HKD\$1,000.
- 2. First Runner-up: One per Section. Awards are a certificate and book coupons with a total value of HKD\$600.
- 3. Second Runner-up: One per Section. Awards are a certificate and book coupons with a total value of HKD\$400.
- 4. Outstanding Award: For participants scoring 85 marks or above. Awards are a certificate and book coupons with a total value of HKD\$100.
- 5. Distinction Award: For participants scoring 75–84 marks. To be awarded with a "Distinction" certificate.
- 6. Merit Award: For participants scoring 60–74 marks. To be awarded with a "Merit" certificate.

(C) School Awards: The total score is calculated based on the combined points from the levels and categories in which a school participates. All schools reaching the required score will receive an award.

Award

Team Award Point

- First Class Award: Schools with a total score of 100 points or above will receive a certificate and book coupons with a total value of HKD\$1,000.
- Diamond Award: Schools with a total score of 70–99 points will receive a certificate and book coupons with a total value of HKD\$600.
- **Platinum Award:** Schools with a total score of **40–69 points** will receive a certificate and book coupons with a total value of HKD\$400.

Notes for Participants:

- After registration is accepted, the school will assign the venue and seat number on the admission ticket and stamp for confirmation. The confirmed admission ticket will be sent/delivered to the participant's school on or before 14 November.
- 2. On the competition day, participants must present the stamped and confirmed admission ticket together with their student ID card (or a handbook with a photo) for identity verification. If the admission ticket is lost, a replacement may be obtained at the school office on the competition day for a fee of HKD\$10.

- 4. Submitted entries will not be returned. The organizer reserves the right to upload the entries and/or participants' photos to the Internet and/or publish them in print.
- 5. The same participant may apply for both the Chinese Section and the English Section of the same level.
- 6. Entry Fee: HKD\$150 per item. For two items, the total fee will be HKD\$250.
- 7. Participants must arrive at the venue 15 minutes before the competition starts for identity verification and seating arrangements.
- 8. Late arrival or absence will not be compensated with extra time or rescheduling.
- 9. Participants must bring their own stationery, including black or blue ballpoint pens and correction pen/tape.
- 10. Only Section applications through schools are accepted. Individual applications will not be accepted.
- 11. As the competition day coincides with the school's Open Day, waiting areas will be provided for teachers and parents.
